I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TSUNAMI ALERT CANCELLATION

A strong local earthquake occurred offshore in Negros Oriental at 11:49 AM (Philippine Time), located at 9.97°N, 123.14°E with depth of 10 km and a preliminary magnitude of 6.9. At 12:31 PM, PHIVOLCS issued a bulletin with Tsunami Alert Level 2 for areas along the coast of the Negros and Cebu Islands, stating that the concerned public is advised to be alert for unusual waves.

PHIVOLCS has received some reports of unusual sea level changes within the projected arrival period of tsunami waves in the Negros and Cebu Islands coasts (11:49 AM to 12:19 PM of 06 February 2012 (Philippine Time)).

No further reports of unusual sea level changes were received after the two-hour extended observation period. <u>Hence, tsunami alerts for the Philippines are now CANCELLED.</u>

This will be the last bulletin issued for this event.
