2. ACTION/S TAKEN

A. Preparedness Measures Undertaken by NDRRMC:

 NDRRMC – OpCen immediately disseminated the information to RDRRMC/OCD Regional Centers I, II, V, CAR, and NCR through facsimile and Short Messaging System (SMS) and advised the above regions to monitor any possible effects of said earthquake particularly in areas with reported intensities

B. Preparedness Measures Undertaken by RDRRMCs, PDRRMCs, M/CDRRMCs

- RDRRMCs/OCDRCs I, II, V, CAR and NCR disseminated earthquake information to Chairperson, MDRRMC and local DRRMCs Members through facsimile and SMS and further advised MDRRMCs and LGUs to disseminate the information through the community leaders and local media
- Constantly coordinating with their respective Provincial Civil Defense Deputized Coordinators for any effects of earthquake in their respective areas of responsibility
