## Flashflood and Landslide Incidents in Compostela Valley Province

#### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 6:00 PM, March 31, 2011, the Hijo River overflowed due to heavy rains
  which resulted in the occurrence of a landslide in the Municipality of Maco. Seven (7)
  highland barangays were affected, namely: Brgys Elizalde, Panibasan, Tagbaros,
  Panoraon, Kinuban, Malamodao and New Leyte.
- On or about 8:00 PM March 31, 2011, a flashflood occurred in Sitio Matagdungan, Bukal, in the Municipality of Nabunturan, due to strong winds and heavy rains

### II. EFFECTS

## A. Affected Population:

 A total of 107 families/491 persons in the Municipality of Maco coming from Brgys Elizalde (31 families/111 persons) and Tagbaros (78 families/ 380 persons) were affected by landslide. No data yet on the population affected in the other barangays who pre-evacuated to safer areas

#### B. Casualties:

 In Nabunturan, two (2) persons identified as Pablo Tibay (50 years old) and Kristine Beronguis (4 years old) were reported dead due to drowning and three (3) others namely: Princess Beronguis (7 years old), Recil Beronguis (6 years old) and Angel Beronguis (9 months old) were reported missing

C. Damaged Roads and Bridges in Maco

Brgy. Elizalde	Roads and bridges going to Tinago - not passable
Brgy. Malamodao	Bridge - not passable
Brgy. Tagbaros	Roads including Brgy Hills in Tagbaros, Elementary School and Tagbaros Bridge - not passable
Brgy. Panoraon	Two (2) bridges - not passable
Brgy. New Leyte	Road from Lumangang going to Bunlag

### D. Damaged Houses and other Structures

- Four (4) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Panoraon
- One (1) BDS Outpost and 2 waiting sheds were damaged in Brgy. Panoraon

#### III. ACTIONS TAKEN

- MDRRMC Maco conducted relief operations and extended food assistance to the affected families, to wit: 100 sacks of rice, 50 boxes of sardines, and 100 boxes of noodles.
- PDRRMC Compostela Valley dispatched heavy equipment and dump trucks for the evacuation of affected families and for the clearing operations of roads.
- · BDRRMCs concerned created an alternate road
- Conduct of damage and needs assessment and close monitoring of the situation by MDRRMC Maco is ongoing
- MDRRMC Maco convened the Sangguniang Bayan for possible declaration of the barangays affected under a State of Calamity
- PDRRMC ComVal and MDRRMC Nabunturan are still conducting SAR operations on the reported 3 missing persons
