I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- Continuous heavy rains in the Province of Negros Occidental, specifically in the municipalities of E.B. Magalona and Victorias City, resulted to a flash flood
- The affected population are as follows:

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- Affected MDRRMCs convened the Council to discuss an appropriate response

- LGU of E.B. Magalona extended family food packs to the affected families of their municipality
- OCD VI is continuously monitoring the situation
