

I. Belated Report on IDPs in Maragusan, Compostela Valley

- Thirty three (33) families/143 individuals were displaced due to an armed encounter between the 66th IB, Philippine Army and the troops of the New People's Army at around 6:25 AM 16 May 2011 at Sitio Camogo, Brgy. Parasanon, Maragusan, Compostela Valley. The displaced families were evacuated at the Parasanon Elementary School

Action Taken

- MDRRMC Maragusan and BDRRMC Parasanon had extended relief assistance to the evacuees

II. Belated Report on Fire Incident in Sta Cruz, Manila

- On or about 10:01 19 May 2011, a fire incident of unknown cause occurred at 2105 G-Felix Huertas Street, Sta Cruz, Manila. The fire started at the 2nd floor of a 2-storey residential structure owned by Felisima Tejoco and was placed under control at 10:00 AM and was put out at 11:41 AM
- More or less 20 families were affected and the estimated cost of damages is approximately PhP1,500,000.00
- One (1), identified as Richard Mariano, 33 years old, a member of the ALHA BROTHERHOOD Volunteer Fire Brigade was electrocuted and his left wrist was also fractured while Maynard Saludad, 25 years old and a member of the Brgy 298 Volunteer Fire Brigade sustained minor cuts on his right hand

Actions Taken

- BFP-Manila and other fire volunteers have responded to the fire scene
- Richard Mariano was brought to the Metropolitan Medical Center in Tondo while Maynard Saludad was treated by members of the EMS personnel
- OCD-NCR coordinated with the Manila Fire Department to determine the extent of the fire

III. Initial Report on Landslide Incident in South Cotabato

- On or about 2:30 PM, 19 May 2011, a landslide occurred in Sitio Ipil-ipil, Kematu, T'boli, South Cotabato due to heavy rains.
- Nine (9) houses were damaged (three (3) totally while six (6) partially).
- Nine (9) families were affected and one (1), identified as Gregorio Mayol, Sr., 46 years old was reported dead

Actions Taken

- BDRRMC Kematu and MDRRMC T'boli conducted damage and needs assessment (DANA) in the affected areas
 - RDCC XII, PDRRMC South Cotabato and MDRRMC Tiboli are continuously monitoring the flood and landslide prone areas in their respective areas of Responsibility (AOR)
