I. Situation Overview

- ❖ Four (4) landslide incidents occurred at Sitio Hangaron, Lumbayao, Valencia City, Bukidnon Province due to continuous heavy rains:

- 1st - 9:00 PM, 3 July 2011 - rendered the roads going to San Fernando and Valencia City impassable to traffic
- 2nd - 8:45 AM 4 July 2011 – major incident
- 3rd - 3:40 PM 4 July 2011 minor incident, rescue teams retrieved 3 dead bodies
- 4th - 3:40 PM 4 July 2011 intermittent landslide was going on due to gushing water from the upper portion of the area
- 5th - 6:25 PM, the Mayor of Valencia (Leonardo Jose Catarata) and the rescue teams decided to call off the search due to heavy rains. Search and retrieval operations to resume tomorrow morning.

- ❖ Three (3) persons were reported dead, namely: Sheryl Sadsad; Segundina S. Lagunay; and Marites S. Lagunay, while eight (8) others are still missing
- ❖ Three (3) persons were reported injured, namely: Reynante Sadsad; Manolito Castro; and Bienvenido Castro, Jr.

II. Actions Taken

- ❖ PDRRMC Bukidnon and CDRRMC Valencia City Emergency Responders and Rescue Teams have immediately responded to the incidents.
- ❖ The DANA team conducted damage and needs assessment to determine the extent of damages.
- ❖ RD Carmelito A. Lupo with Bukidnon Provincial Coordinator Visminda Y. Cordero conducted ocular inspection with PAGASA and MGB representatives in coordination with CDRRMC Chairman and LDRRMO Officers.

III. Needs

- ❖ Additional heavy equipments such as bulldozer, grader, and payloaders are needed for clearing operations.
