I. Situation Overview

- On or about 2:00 PM, 20 July 2011, a flooding incident occurred in two (2) barangays in Zamboanga City namely: Brgy. Bungiao and Brgy. Bolong due to heavy rainfall
- A total of 139 families/469 persons were affected: 69 families/259 persons in Brgy. Bungiao and 70 families/210 persons in Purok Manga, Brgy. Bolong
- Five (5) houses were totally damaged (4 in Brgy. Bungiao and 1 in Brgy. Bolong) and twenty four (24) houses were partially (16 in Brgy. Bungiao and 8 in Brgy. Bolong)
- No casualties reported

II. Actions Taken

- OCD FO IX continues to monitor and coordinate with CDRRMC and concerned agencies
- City Social Welfare and Development Office immediately provided relief and food assistance
