#### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

Two (2) incidents of vehicular accident occurred in the following areas:

##### 1. Skyway near Sucat Exit (Southbound)

- On July 26, 2011 at 11:30 AM, a vehicular accident involving a Dimple Star Transit Bus with plate number 7511, crashed at the East Service Road, Barangay Marcelo Village, Parañaque City

#### Casualties

#### Actions Taken

- PRC-Parañaque, Makati Rescue and Skyway Rescue Team responded to the incident and brought the victims to Parañaque Medical Center for medical treatment
- OCD-NCR will follow up with updates

## **2. Ayala Tunnel, EDSA (Southbound)**

- On July 26, 2011 at 11:30 AM, a multiple vehicle collision incident involving three (3) passenger buses and four (4) vans occurred at the Ayala Tunnel, EDSA (Southbound)

### **Casualties**

- There were four (4) injured; two of them are foreigners

### **Actions Taken**

- Makati Rescue, Guadalupe Viejo Rescue Team, BFP, MMDA and Makati Police responded to the incident and brought one of the injured foreigners to the Makati Medical Center while the rest, with only minor injuries, signed a waiver for refusal of treatment
  - OCD-NCR continuously monitors the situation
