I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

 A Vietnamese FB sunk at the vicinity 45NM SE of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (Lat 09.36N, Long 119.25 E) on 272300H July 2011, due to unfavourable weather condition, as reported by Mr. Edwin Aban to CGDet Balabac upon receiving a text message from concerned citizen informing him about the incident

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- Through the exerted efforts by CGDet Balacbac, they were able to contact a certain Lung Ming Coen, a Vietnamese National of Brgy. Lourdes, Puerto Princesa, Palawan and requested her to inform the relatives of the twelve (12) Vietnamese fishermen from Quang Ngai, Vietnam
- Said Vietnamese Fishermen were rescued by FV Monalinda (owned and operated by Monalinda Fishing Corp.) at the vicinity waters of Brgy. Caramay, Roxas, Palawan on 281200H July 11
- CGDet Balabac Personnel rendered necessary assistance during the arrival of FV Monalinda and disembarkation of 12 Vietnamese fishermen at Roxas Pier, Roxas, Palawan on 280800H July 2011:
