1. Malabon City

I. Situation Overview

- On or about 3:53 AM, 27 August 2011, a fire incident involving a warehouse (Philippine American Sheets) owned by Edward Sy at Rivera St., Tanyag, Malabon City (near City Hall)
- Fire alarm level reached 5th alarm at 4:42 AM; declared fire under control at 7:45 AM; and fire out at 9:58 AM
- Fire reportedly originated at the Painting Station (2nd floor) of the warehouse
- No casualty reported and more or less Php 2 Million estimated cost of damages
- Cause of fire – still under investigation

II. Actions Taken

- BFP- Malabon and nearby BFP fire stations and Fire Volunteers responded to the Fire Incident;
- OCD- NCR monitored the situation and coordinated with the Malabon City Fire Department to confirm and determine the extent of fire

2. Valenzuela City

I. Situation Overview

- On or about 8:21 PM, 24 August 2011, a fire incident involving the Home Best Furniture warehouse occurred at Landa St., 1st Malinta Compound, Don Pablo Subd., Brgy. Rincon, Valenzuela City occupied by David Lee and Elizabeth Lee
- The alarm level reached to Task Force Alpha at 9:54 PM, 24 August 2011; declared under control at 12:26 AM, 25 August 2011; and fire out at 2:08 AM, 26 August 2011
- Fire reportedly originated at the ground floor of the warehouse while the cause of fire is still under investigation
- No casualty reported
- More or less Php 15,000,000.00 estimated cost of damages

II. Actions Taken

- BFP- Valenzuela, two (2) fire trucks from the Fire District and other fire volunteers and ambulances responded to the incident
- OCD–NCR monitored the situation
