I. OVERVIEW

- At 8:00 AM today, the Tropical Depression was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 1,480 KM East of southern Mindanao (5.7°N, 140.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 KPH near the center. It is forecast to move west at the 19 KPH. It is expected to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility by tomorrow morning
- This Tropical Depression is still outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR)

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
