### I. OVERVIEW

- At 8:00 AM today, the Tropical Depression was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 1,480 KM East of southern Mindanao (5.7°N, 140.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 KPH near the center. It is forecast to move west at the 19 KPH. It is expected to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility by tomorrow morning
- This Tropical Depression is still outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR)

### II. ACTION/S TAKEN

 NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. 01 for Tropical Depression was disseminated to all OCD Regions through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
