OVERVIEW

- Wind convergence is expected to affect Eastern Luzon which will bring scattered to widespread rains particularly over Isabela, Aurora, Quezon Provinces and Bicol region which may trigger flashfloods and landslides
- However, the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) will continue to affect Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao which will bring scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms
