SITUATION OVERVIEW

- MDRMC Calinog, Iloilo reported that four (4) barangays in said municipality were affected by a water contamination. Based on investigation, the causes of water contamination are as follows:
 - Brgy. Badu water pump owned by Mr. Crispin Libero where the residents get their water for drinking regularly
 - Brgy. Gama Grande water source is near the toilets and pig pens which greatly contributed to the water contamination
 - Brgy. Dalid food
- Gerald Castilla (1 year old) was reported dead

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ACTION/S TAKEN

- LGU Calinog provided assistance in the form of antidotes and other measures to the victims
- MDRRMC Calinog is still conducting an inspection and further verification of the incident and recommended the following measures:
 - Boiling of drinking water
 - Environmental sanitation with water chlorination of all deep wells and water source
 - Repair of the drainage system
 - Relocation of pig pens and toilets away from the water source
 - Intensive campaign on water disinfection and analysis with Bacteriological Examination by Rural Sanitation, Midwives and Nurses concerned in the affected municipality
