1. Armed Conflict in Brgy San Roque, Panabo City

- On or about 6:45 PM 11 November 2011, elements of the 69th IB PA stationed in Brgy. San Roque, Panabo City were harassed by an undetermined number of suspected NPA rebels while conducting checkpoint operations within the vicinity. The said rebels maneuvered at the back portion of the detachment then hurled a grenade then opened fire afterwards
- The encounter wounded seven (7) individuals, namely: Sgt Tapat, 16 years old, Cpl Rino Arenas, 28 years old; PFC Elmer Laroya, 23 years old; PFC Dennis de los Reyes, 24 years old; CAFGU Maximo Gementiza, 43 years old; Noli Paglinawan, 48 years old; and Brgy Tanod Dominico Camanci, 38 years old

Actions Taken

- The wounded victims were rushed to the Rivera Hospital in Panabo City then later transferred to the Southern Philippines Medical Center in Davao City
- City Mayor Jose L. Silvosa, Sr. extended financial assistance to the victims

2. Fire Incident in NCR

- On or about 7:40 PM 14 November 2011, a fire incident occurred at Sanchez La Torre Street, Tondo, Manila involving a 3 storey apartment with more or less Php100,000.00 estimated damages. Cause of fire is still under investigation.

Actions Taken

- OCD-NCR coordinated with BFP – Manila to confirm and determine the extent of fire
- BFP Manila and other fire volunteers responded to the incident

3. Grenade Explosion in Cotabato

- On or about 9:40 PM 14 November 2011, a grenade exploded at Prk 10-A, Brgy. Poblacion, Carmen, Cotabato Province leaving **1 dead identified as Joseph Tomelden and wounding 22, namely:**

Actions Taken

- The victims were rushed to the nearest hospital for medical treatment
 - Joint PNP and AFP EOD Team immediately proceeded to the area to conduct post blast investigation
