I. National Capital Region (NCR)

NIA Road, Quezon City

Situation Overview:

- On or about 1:18 AM, 20 November 2011, a fire incident occurred at NIA Road, Brgy. Pinyahan, Quezon City affecting more or less 1,500 families / 7,500 persons. The cause of the fire remains under investigation
- Three (3) were reported dead, <u>Alfred John Alcala</u> (10 months old); <u>Arianne Joy Alcala</u> (7 years old), while <u>one was still unidentified</u>. Four (4) were injured, to name: <u>Ranny Pangatuan</u> (33 years old); <u>Louie Espiel</u> (27 years old); <u>Maritess Coreta</u> (27 years old); and <u>Jenny Sumali</u> (28 years old)
- A total of more or less 700 houses were burned and the estimated cost of damages was pegged at PhP 7 Million

Actions Taken:

- BFP-QC, nearby BFP fire stations, DPOS, and fire volunteers responded to the incident

Luzon Avenue, Quezon City

Situation Overview:

 A fire incident occured at Calamansi Street, Luzon Avenue, Quezon City on or about 4:47 PM 20 November 2011 involving an apartment building. The cause of the fire, affected families, number of houses burned and cost of damages is not yet determine. No casualties reported.

Actions Taken:

- BFP-QC and other fire volunteers responded to the incident
- Progress report to follow

II. Region VIII

St. Bernard, Southern Leyte

Situation Overview:

 On or about 10:10 PM, 19 November 2011, a fire incident transpired at Dumataas Sari Store, owned by Mr. Alden Dumataas, a Muslim businessman, at Brgy.

- Himatagon, Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte. Two (2) residential/commercial houses and seven (7) commercial stalls were totally burned
- Findings by the fire Arson SFOI Edilberto R. Lopez revealed the cause of fire was purely electrical short circuit and more or less Php 10 Million estimated cost of damages

Actions Taken:

- BFP Saint Bernard; Municipal Disaster Response Teams; Southern Leyte Emergency Response Team (SOLERT); San Juan Fire Station; Hinunangan Liloan, Libagon, Bontoc, Sogod and Macrohon Fire Volunteers proceeded to the fire scene
- BFP St. Bernard and the Response Teams continuously monitoring the fire incident area
- RDRRMC and MDRRMC Saint Bernard conducted emergency meeting together with the victims of fire incidents

III. Region X

Kapatagan, Lanao del Norte

Situation Overview:

- On or about 2:00 AM, 20 November 2011, a fire incident occurred at P-2 Taguitic, Kapatagan, Lanao del Norte affecting 15 families / 75 persons. The cause of the fire is still under investigation
- Eleven (11) houses were totally burned and four (4) were partially damaged
- Two (2) were injured namely; <u>Mae Lumagdas</u> (6 years old) and <u>Jessa Mae Lumagpas</u> (7 years old), both admitted at Provincial Hospital, Kapatagan Lanao del Norte

Actions Taken:

BFP Kapatagan responded to the incident
