A. Flooding/Flashflood Incidents

Davao del Norte and Davao Oriental (Progress Report)

- On November 8, 2011 flooding occurred in Panabo City, Carmen, and **Braulo Dujali** in Davao del Norte and Mati City, Davao Oriental due to heavy rains brought by Inter tropical Convergence Zones (ITCZ)
- 100 families from Brgys Dapco and San Francisco, Panabo City evacuated to the church and packing plants.. Evacuees have already returned home
- 5,989 families/29,945 persons** from 11 barangays in Carmen, Davao del Norte and **390 families / 1,950 persons** from three brgys in **Braulo Dujali** were affected
- 430.73 has of agricultural production (crops) and 80 has. of fisheries were damaged in Carmen, Davao del Norte**

- In Mati City, Davao Oriental, Brgy Central was affected with one house partially damaged

Actions Taken

- **PDRPMC Davao del Norte and MDRRMCs Carmen and Braulo Dujali extended relief assistance**
- Panabo City Emergency and Rescue service headed by CDRRMO Augusto Quilisaldio conducted rescue and evacuation operations
- MDRRMC Carmen, Davao del Norte and Panabo City Emergency Response Service conducted damage and needs assessment in the affected areas
- CDRRMC Response Group of Mati Davao Oriental immediately responded to the flooded areas
- RDRRMC XI is continuously monitoring the situation in the provinces of Davao del Norte and Davao Oriental

Valencia City, Bukidnon (Progress Report)

- On or about 6:40 PM, 10 November 2011, a flashflood incident occurred at Bagongta-as, Valencia City, Bukidnon due to heavy rains. The flood waters subsided at 7:30 PM
- Twenty (20) houses were damaged and the 20 families evacuated to the designated evacuation centers at the height of the flood

Actions Taken

- CDRRMC Valencia City and Rescue Team conducted ocular survey and rapid damage assessment and needs analysis in the area
- CDRRMC thru CSWD Valencia City extended relief/food assistance to the affected families
- RDRRMC X is continuously monitoring the situation

B. Fire Incidents in NCR

Caloocan City

- On or about 9:30 AM, 10 November 2011, a fire incident involving a residential house and a school building occurred at 120 Int. Malonzo St. corner Samson Road, Caloocan City
- The estimated cost of damages was placed at more or less one (1) Million pesos
- One person identified as Edgardo Agapito suffered laceration at the right knee
- The cause of fire is still under investigation

Action Taken

- BFP Caloocan and other fire volunteers have responded to the fire scene

Valenzuela City

- On or about 3:15 PM, 10 November 2011, a fire incident involving a warehouse, occurred at 1020 Don Pablo Subd., Brgy. Rincon, Valenzuela City
- The cause of fire, casualty and cost of damages are still to be determined

Action Taken

- BFP Valenzuela City and other fire volunteers have responded to the fire scene

Parañaque City

- On or about 11:24 AM, 11 November 2011, a fire incident occurred at Bonifacio Extension San Dionesio, Parañaque City involving a commercial establishment
- The cause of fire, casualty and cost of damages are still to be determined

Action Taken

- BFP Parañaque City and other fire volunteers have responded to the fire scene
- OCD-NCR closely monitoring the situation

C. Mechanical Accident (Caterpillar Ride) in Valenzuela City

- On or about 09:45 PM, 09 November 2011, a mechanical accident occurred along McArthur Hi-way corner A. Pablo St., Brgy. Karuhatan, Valenzuela City.
- The couch of Caterpillar Ride at the Mini Carnival was detached from its hold which caused the victims to be ejected from the couch
- Neil Rapol E. Abad, 41 years old, died on the spot while nine (9) others were injured and brought to the hospital

Action Taken

- Valenzuela rescue teams, Barangay rescue team, and CSI of Valenzuela City headed by CSI Quiñonez have responded to the incident

D. Tornado

- On or about 5:30 PM, 10 November 2011, a tornado incident occurred at Quiajo, Pres. Roxas, Capiz. Said incident at the sea shore between Pres. Roxas and Pilar
- No damage was reported

Action Taken

- OCD-RDRRMC is closely monitoring the situation
