**SITUATION OVERVIEW**

- On or around 2:15 PM 10 December 2011, a Beech Craft Queen Air two-seater type of aircraft with plane number RPC824 bound for San Jose Mindoro from the Domestic Runway crashed at Dona Soledad Subdivision, Better Living, Parañaque City. The aircraft crashed into a residential house and the F. Serrano Elementary School

**EFFECTS:**

- The plane crash affected 20 families or 100 individuals, mostly children
- Fifty-six (56) families were evacuated to the covered court of Annex 35**
- Affected 20 houses mostly made up of light materials and two (2) school buildings
- The estimated cost of damage is PHP 6,000,000.00

**CASUALTIES:**

- 13 dead (3 from the plane, 10 killed on site), 6 of which remain unidentified; 15 injured, 5 of which remain unidentified. Breakdown is as follows:

**ACTIONS TAKEN:**

- **Congressman Rollo Golez provided food assistance to the affected families**
  - **Barangay Officials of Brgy. Don Bosco assisted and assessed the needs of the families affected**
  - Barangays Don Bosco and Moonwalk Response Teams, Paranaque and Las Pinas BFP, PRC Rizal Chapter, Paranaque City Rescue, PNP, CDAG Sampaloc, Raha, Alliance, MIAA Fire & Rescue, MMDA, CSWO Paranaque, DSWD-NCR, BFP Malabon, BFP Makati, BFP Pandacan, BFP Manila, NCR Fire District 3 Dept., Parañaque Doctores Hospital and other volunteer groups responded to the incident
  - All the casualties were brought to the Royalty Funeral homes, Marcos Alvarez, Moonwalk, Las Pinas City
  - BPF, PRC, Paranaque Rescue, and the Civil Defense Action Group (CDAG) are conducting rescue and retrieval operations
  - SOCO Team from the Southern Police District (SPD), BFP Paranaque, and Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) conducted an investigation at the crash site
  - **Red Cross-Parañaque continued its welfare desk and first-aid station operation at the evacuation area to treat minor injuries and burns. Hot meals, grocery items and clothes were distributed to affected families**
  - **DSWD-NCR provided 100 blankets and 100 mattresses to the victims**
  - OCD NCR followed up with SPD for the latest updates on the incidents; and coordinated with the NAIA Media Relations Office, CAAP, and responders and is continuously monitoring the situation
