Drowning Incident in San Juan, La Union

A. Situation Overview

- On or about 4:00 am, Dec. 18, 2011 along the shoreline of Brgy. Urbiztondo, San Juan, La Union, a group of persons went swimming and were engulfed by a big wave and carried by a strong current of water. At around 8:00 am 19 Dec. 2011, PCG SAR Team onboard rubber boat proceeded to the area and a cadaver was sighted approximately 500 yards away from the PPIC Pier 2 and retrieved around 9:30 am of said date
