I. PARAÑAQUE CITY

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 1:30 PM, 25 December 2011, a fire incident occurred at Block 1 Lot 2 Marcelo, Sucat, Parañaque that reached the 2nd Alarm
- Said incident involved 20 residential houses made of light materials and affected 60 families
- It was declared fire out at around 2:45 PM
- The cause and origin of the fire are still under investigation
- Estimated damages was more or less PhP 1.5 Million

EFFECTS

No casualties were reported

ACTIONS TAKEN

- BFP Parañague City and other fire volunteers responded immediately to the area
- OCD-NCR monitored the situation and coordinated with BFP Parañaque for final report

II. MANDALUYONG CITY

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 5:45 AM, 26 December 2011, a fire incident took place at 508 Boni Avenue, Mandaluyong City that reached the 1st Alarm
- A commercial establishment was involved and fire out was declared at 6:23
 AM
- The cause and origin of the fire are still under investigation
- The damage was estimated at more or less PhP 750,000.00

EFFECTS

No casualties were reported

ACTIONS TAKEN

 BFP Mandaluyong City and other fire volunteers responded immediately to the area OCD-NCR monitored the situation and coordinated with BFP Mandaluyong City for final report

III. MARIKINA CITY

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 10:50 AM, 26 December 2011, a fire incident occurred at Gil Fernando along Marcos Highway, Marikina City which reached the 4th alarm and was confined at 11:27 AM
- · Said incident involves a commercial establishment
- · The origin, cause and estimated damages are yet to be determined
