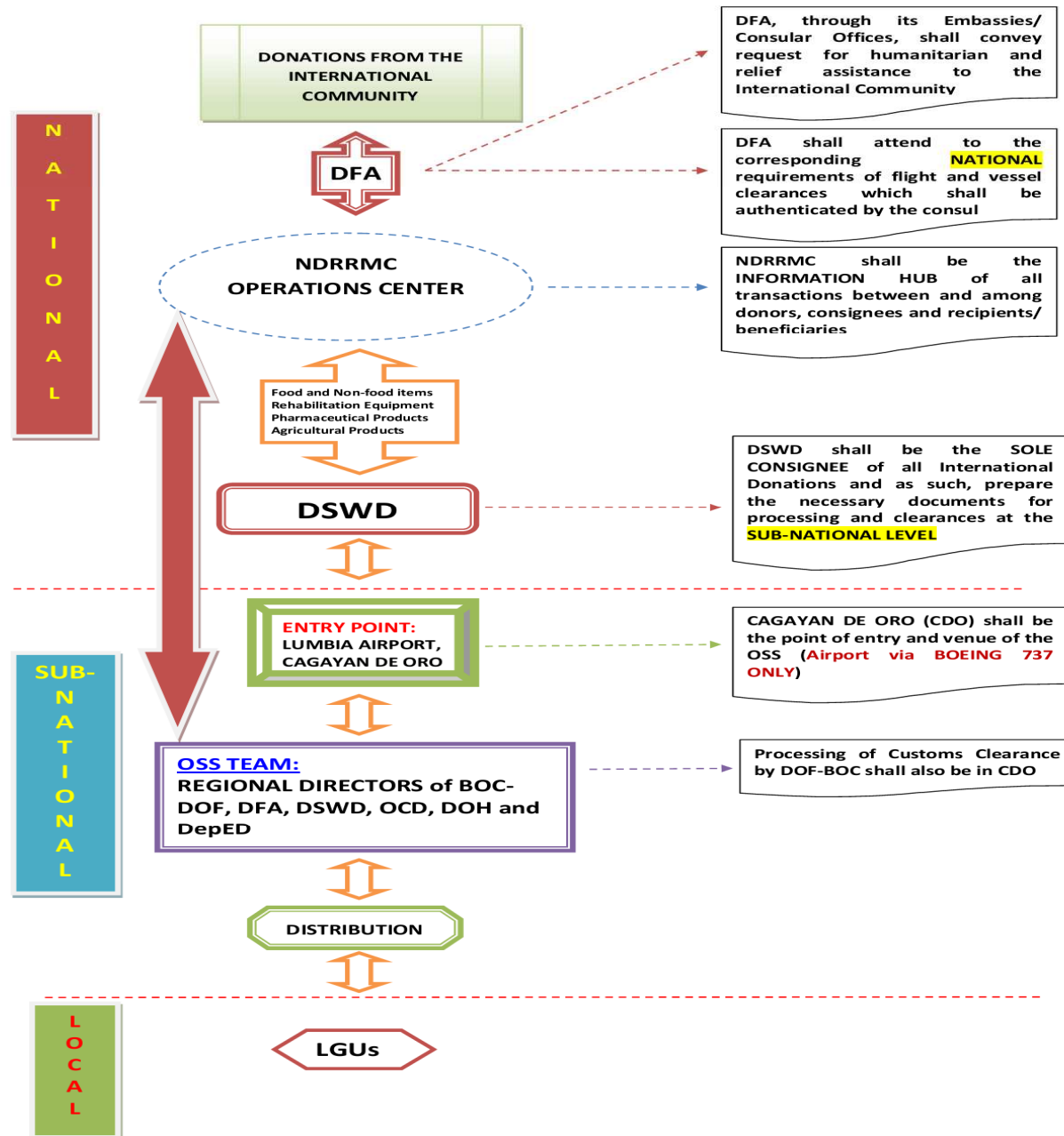

“ONE-STOP SHOP”

- ❑ A mechanism to expedite the processing and release of importations of donated goods/ articles/ equipment intended for calamity-declared areas and victims of disasters
- ❑ Established in all collection districts of the BOC to be headed by the DOF and composed of authorized representatives from the DSWD, DOE, DOH, DA, DND and other agencies concerned
- ❑ Available 24/7 for the processing and immediate release of foreign donated articles from the BOC

URGENT NEEDS

- ✓ Tents (shelters)
- ✓ Cooking utensils
- ✓ Sleeping mattresses
- ✓ Blankets
- ✓ Clothing
- ✓ Mosquito nets
- ✓ Flashlights (preferably Torch) with batteries
- ✓ Assorted medicines
- ✓ Underwear (adult: M/F and children's sizes)
- ✓ Food
- ✓ Water, sanitation and hygiene requirements
- ✓ Tent clinics/hospitals
- ✓ Medical equipment
- ✓ Classroom tents
