I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- At about 5:15 PM of February 23, 2012. A shooting and hacking incident transpired at Sitio Bahaing, Tininghalang, Lapuyan in the Province of Zamboanga del Sur, wherein the suspects shot and threw a grenade to victims houses resulting to multiple death and injuries due to shrapnel wounds.
- The shooting and hacking incident resulted to the death of six (6) persons, four (4) were in critical condition and five (5) minor injuries , identified as follows:

Dead - 6

1. Jun-Jun Tumbal Banghulot – 62 years old, Male/Married
2. Rex Banghulot Langhay – 9 years old, Male/Child
3. Raquel Banghulot Langhay – 28 years old, Female/Married
4. Hendrito Bayamban Morales – 11 years old, male /Child
5. Daylin Daana Gulpin – 25 years old, Female / Married
6. Daryl Daana Gulpin – 2 years old, Male / Infant

Injured - 9

1. Webb Cadodog Humpa -37 years old, Male/Married
2. Regine Langhay Banghulot – 2 years old, Female/Infant
3. Ran-Ran Langhay Banghulot – 6 years old, Male/Child
4. Larabelle Siput Banghulot – 12 years old, Female/Child
5. Judy Ann Siput Banghulot – 14 years old, Female/Child
6. Benedict Siput Banghulot – 10 years old, Male /Child
7. Justine Gulpin Siay – 7 years old, Male / Child
8. Monsour Humpa Tambagal – 15 years old, Male/Child
9. Unidentified – Male/Child

- Injured victims were brought to Margosatubig Regional Hospital for medical treatment
- Affected IDPs opted to stay with their relatives in the nearby barangay.
- No Evacuation Center was established

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- PNP elements of Lapuyan MPS together with friendly forces (AFP & CVOs) are continuously conducting hot pursuit/manhunt operation to neutralize the perpetrators
 - Municipal Peace and Order Council (POC) conducted meeting.
 - MSWDO – Lapuyan extended 100 packs of food assistance to the affected families.
 - LGUs-MHO gave Php20,000.00 worth of food items to the victims admitted in the hospital
 - Lapuyan Mayor's Office will provide caskets and embalming materials for the dead persons
 - Cash assistance worth Php10,000.00 per beneficiary of the dead persons and Php5,000.00 for the injured persons are ready for immediate distribution
 - OCD-RC 9 Operations Center in continuous monitoring with the situation and constantly coordination with the Lapuyan-MDRRMC, MSWDO & PRO 9
