1. Situation Overview

The municipality of San Fernando, Romblon has a total of **195 diarrheal cases** from 26 February 2012 to 19 March 2012 in the following **eleven (11)** barangays: Brgys. **Agtiwa**, Azagra, Campalingo, **Espana**, **Mabini**, **Mabulo**, **Otod**, Panagcalan, Pili, Poblacion and Taclobo. As of **21 March 2012**, data showed that **one hundred twenty-six (126)** cases were consulted at the Rural Health Unit (RHU) from **5-19 March 2012** and **sixty-nine (69)** patients were admitted in Sibuyan District Hospital (SDH). As of 20 March 2012, there are still **six (6)** patients admitted in Sibuyan District Hospital and a total of **sixty (60) discharged patients**.
