#### A. EARTHQUAKE IN BAGUIO CITY

#### Situation Overview

An earthquake occurred in Baguio City. Details are as follows

#### **B. FIRE INCIDENT IN QUEZON CITY**

#### Situation Overview

- On or about 11:44 AM 28 March 2012, a fire incident occurred in 630 Victoria Avenue, Brgy Tatalon, Quezon City burning approximately 300 houses and affecting more or less 500 families
- The fire was said to have started in the three storey house of Mrs. Cristina Abella y Naba.
- The fire was placed under control at 12:35 PM 28 March 2012 and was declared out at 1:50 PM 28 March 2012
- The cost of damages was estimated at PhP 2,000,000.00

#### **Actions Taken:**

- BFP Quezon City and other firefighters from nearby cities responded to the incident
- An ambulance also responded to the incident
- OCD-NCR is continuously monitoring the situation

#### C. FIRE INCIDENT IN CAINTA, RIZAL

#### **Situation Overview**

- On or about 2:55 PM 29 March 2012, a fire incident occurred in Lakas Tao Floodway, San Andres, Cainta, Rizal
- The fire was said to have originated in a room rented by a certain Helen Napao Bokinglaito in a residential house owned by Mrs. Joventina Dante
- The fire burned down 50 houses made of light materials and affected approximately 100 families. The affected families were evacuated to Brgy San Andres Covered Court
- The estimated cause of damage is PhP 200,000.00

### Actions Taken:

- Fire engines from Cainta, Pasig Fire, Pasig Volunteers, Marikina Fire, Marikina Volunteers, and other fire volunteers responded to the incident
- Mayor Ramon Ilagan and the staff of MSWDO Cainta is currently conducting validation of the affected families. Food and other relief goods were given to the victims
- PSWD Rizal is also conducting validation and is distributing food, clothing, and financial assistance to the affected families
