Special Weather Outlook for the Holy Week

1. WEATHER OUTLOOK:

The whole country including Metro Manila will have generally good weather condition apart from afternoon or evening rainshowers or thunderstorms starting Monday (2 April 2012) until Thursday (5 April 2012). However, the recurrence of the tail end of a cold front and the trough of the Low Pressure Area is expected to affect the Northern and Central Luzon and Mindanao bringing scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms beginning Friday (6 April 2012) onwards to the outlook period.

Moderate to strong northeasterly winds will continue to prevail over Luzon and Visayas and the coastal waters will be moderate to rough. Fishermen along the seaboard of Luzon are alerted against moderate to high waves generated by the strong northeasterly winds.

No tropical cyclone development is expected throughout the outlook period
