A. Fire Incident in Manila

Situation Overview

- On or about 11:25 PM 2 April 2012, a fire incident involving informal settlers occurred in 945 Luzon Street, Tondo, Manila, burning approximately 50 houses and affecting more or less 100 families
- The estimated cost of damages is PhP 1,000,000.00

Actions Taken:

- BFP Manila and firefighters from nearby cities responded to the incident
- OCD-NCR is continuously monitoring the situation

B. Oil Spill in Misamis Oriental

Situation Overview

- On or about 3:00 AM 3 April 2012, an oil spill occurred in the Petron Depot, Brgy Casinglot, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental.
- Petron personnel, while conducting product transfer operations, did not notice that the
 valve going to the canal was slightly opened, consequently spilling gasoline to the nearby
 mangrove area. The valve was immediately closed upon discovery.
- an equivalent of approximately five (5) drums of gasoline were spilt in the area

Actions Taken:

CGDNM proceeded to the area to clean up and recover the spilled gasoline at 8:15 AM 3
April 2012 and warned nearby residents not to use open flame for the time being. The
team completed the cleanup at 2:45 PM 3 April 2012

Other Information:

 An Inspection/Apprehension Report (IAR) was issued to Petron-Tagoloan for spilling gasoline and for failure to notify the CGDNM of the incident. The Depot Superintendent is ordered to appear before the IAR officer within ten (10) days from receipt of IAR

C. Vehicular Accident in Cotabato Province

Situation Overview

 On or about 9:50 PM 3 April 2012, a vehicular accident occurred along the National Highway, Brgy Tibao, M'lang, Cotabato Province when the driver of a truck without license plates lost control of his vehicle, killing one (1) and injuring 28 others

Actions Taken:

- MDRRMC M'lang brought the victims to the M'lang District Hospital for medical treatment
- Elements of M'lang Municipal Police Station immediately responded to the incident and assisted in bringing the victims to various hospitals in the area. M'lang PNP is conducting an investigation to determine the cause of the accident

D. Food Poisoning in Palawan

Situation Overview

- Food poisoning was reported due to the ingestion of suman (sweet rice cake) in Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.
- Employees of the Palawan Provincial Capitol complained of nausea, dizziness, vomiting, and abdominal pain after eating suman sold in the Capitol. 32 persons were affected due to the incident. Details area as follows:
