1. Fire Incident in Pangil, Laguna

SITUATION OVERVIEW

 On or about 0115H, 12 April 2012, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Palacio, Brgy. Balian, Pangil, Laguna. Cause of fire was a lighted candle. The fire was declared out at 0125H.
 One (1) residential house was totally damaged with an estimated cost of PhP 300,000.00. No casualty reported

- Three (3) fire trucks from Siniloan, Paete, and Famy responded to the incident
- PDRRMO Laguna Medic/Rescue Team also responded to the incident
- OCD/RDRRMC IV-A coordinated with PDRRMO Laguna and BFP Pangil regarding the incident
