#### **Civil Disturbance in Parañaque City**

##### **SITUATION OVERVIEW**

- On 23 April 2012, a demolition team from the City Government of Parañaque was dispatched along the vicinity of Silverio Compound to effect a demolition order on informal settlers when a group of protesters barricaded the compound purportedly to stop the demolition team.
- At 10:00 AM of the same day, a Philippine National Police Task Force led by a certain PSUPT. Beltran was dispatched to negotiate with the protesters. Despite repeated demands and warnings to remove the barricades, the protesters refused as they started throwing stones and empty bottles.
- Despite the resistance, the task force was able to clear the barricades at 11:00 AM.
- Demolition in on-going as of this reporting time.

##### **EFFECTS**

- A certain Arnel Tolentino, 21 y/o and resident of Silverio Compound died due to head injury.
- A total of thirty-nine persons were injured of whom fifteen were members of the PNP and twenty-four (24) civilians.
- Of those injured, ten (10) were brought to the Parañaque Community Hospital, one (1) to the Medical Center of Parañaque, one (1) to the Phil. General Hospital and the rest were rushed to nearby hospitals.

##### **ACTIONS TAKEN**

- Parañaque Police, Parañaque Rescue Team, BFP Parañaque, PRC Parañaque, San Dionisio Rescue, San Isidro Rescue and CDRRM Office dispatched their respective teams to the area.
- OCD-NCR is continuously monitoring the situation.
