Progress Report re Flooding Incident in Poblacion Zone 4, Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 7:30 PM, 26 April 2012, a flashflood occurred at Poblacion Zone 4, Sta.
 Cruz, Davao del Sur due to overflow of Pilan River caused by continuous heavy rainfall.
- As of 7:00 AM 27 April 2012, flood waters had already subsided.
- There was no report of missing or dead casualties.

III. ACTIONS TAKEN

- MDRRMC Sta. Cruz, PNP, BFP, 10ID PA, SAVERS and PRC conducted rescue operations and assisted in the evacuation of the affected population to the Municipal Gym.
- MHO Sta. Cruz staff were at the area to aid the affected population.
- LGU Sta. Cruz & Zone 4 local officials facilitated the transfer of evacuees from the Municipal Gym to the Barangay Gym and GKK San Jose Chapel in Zone 4, Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur.
- LGU and MSWDO provided hot meals thru community kitchen and distributed relief assistance from the Philippine Red Cross and other donors.
- DWSD FO XI provided relief assistance to 300 families such as; food packs, 25 plastic pails, 25 pieces basin, 25 pieces of cooking pot
