I. Fire Incident

Situation Overview

- On or about 8:16AM, 23 May 2012, fire incident occurred in Zone Lower Kamansi, Paknaan, Mandaue City
- About 193 residential houses were involved which are made of light materials with an estimated cost of P250,000.00
- · Cause of fire is still under investigation

Actions Taken

 The BFP Mandaue City and Cebu City, the Emergency Rescue Units Foundation (ERUF), Lapulapu Fire Station, Chinese Volunteer Brigade and the Philippine Red Cross responded to the incident

II. Food Poisoning Incidents

A. Balanga City, Bataan

Situation Overview

- Food poisoning incident was reported in Brgys Cabog Cabog and Tanato, all of Balanga City wherein 44 children and 8 adults were affected
- Victims were involved in the DepEd program "Brigada Eskwela", initial report said that victims ate dirty ice cream
- PNP Balanga is conducting investigation on the incident

Actions Taken

- Victims were brought to Bataan General Hospital for medical treatment
- The Balanga Rescue Team headed by Engr. Dennis Mariano responded to the incident and brought the victims to the nearest hospital

B. Puerto Princesa, Palawan

Situation Overview

 Twenty-six (26) Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) chairmen from Quezon City, Paranaque, Bulacan and Baguio were rushed in Palawan Adventist Hospital in Puerto Princesa

- City after complaining of severe stomach ache, vomiting and passage of loose watery stools.
- Patients may have suffered from apparent food poisoning from the food they ate the night before they were rushed to the hospital. Doctors have yet to determine what caused the severe stomach ache.

III. Whirlwind Incident

Situation Overview

- Whirlwind incident occurred in Purok 10 Brgy Sinayawan, Valencia City on 22 May 2012, 3:00PM
- Twelve (12) families / 74 persons were affected. Twelve (12) houses were reported partially damaged.

Actions Taken

 The LDRRMC-DANA team is conducting further damage and needs assessment in the area
