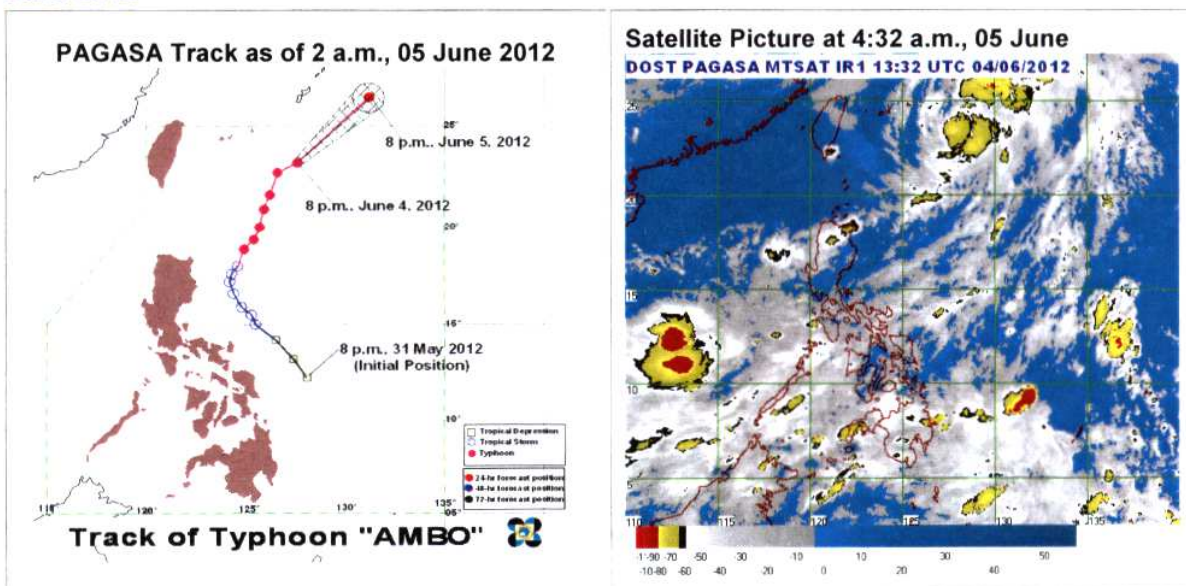

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Severe Weather Bulletin No. 17 (FINAL) re Typhoon "AMBO" (MAWAR) issued at 5:00 AM, 05 June 2012



Typhoon "AMBO" continues to move away from the country in a northeast direction

Location of Center: (as of 4:00 a.m.)	740 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes
Coordinates:	24.8°N, 128.8°E
Strength:	Maximum winds of 130 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 160 kph
Movement:	Moving Northeast at 24 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	Tuesday afternoon: 790 km East Northeast of Taiwan

No Public Storm Warning Signals Raised

- TY “AMBO” will continue to enhance the Southwest Monsoon and bring occasional rains over Luzon particularly over the western section.
- Meanwhile, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 450 km East of Mindanao (7.0°N, 130.0°E).

IV. EMERGENCY RESPONSE MANAGEMENT

NDRRMC

- **NDRRMC–OPCEN** was upgraded its alert status from “Blue Alert” to “Red Alert” effective 8:00 AM, 03 June 2012 due to intensification of TY “AMBO” in Philippine Area of Responsibility.
- PAGASA advised the Binga FFWS Dam Office re Commencement of Preparatory Phase of Flood Warning Operation for the Agno River and Magat FFWS Dam Office for the Magat River dated 01 June 2012 at 9:00 AM and 11:30 AM respectively. NDRRMC OPCEN disseminated to OCD Regions I and II for precautionary measures.
- PAGASA likewise issued Notice of Dam Discharge Warning Operation of Binga Dam Warning No. 01 dated 01 June 2012, 11:35 AM which was disseminated to RDRRMC/OCD CAR for precautionary measures.

AFP

- **NAVFORSOL** requested from HPN the availability of PN aircrafts for SAR operations in Catanduanes

RDRRMCs, Local DRRMCs Response Efforts

A. Region IV-A

1. **COLLAPSED Foundation of a Bridge (under construction)**
 - a. San Mateo DRRMO conducted SAR Operations
2. **DROWNING Incident in Cainta, Rizal**
 - a. Cainta DRRMO conducted SAR Operations
 - b. **Joint BFP Cainta, SWAT Team and GSO recovered the dead body of the victim on June 3, 2012**
3. **ERODED DPWH Rip-rap**
 - a. CDRRMO Antipolo visited the site to assess the damage and alerted DPWH for immediate repairs
 - b. OCD-RDRRMC IV-A is continuously coordinating with DPWH Region IV-A and DEO, CDRRMO-Antipolo, PDRRMO-Rizal for updates and proper action

B. Region IV-B

1. **MONGPONG BRIDGE**
 - a. PDRRMO Occidental Mindoro installed early warning signs and devices on both approaches to caution commuters and diverted traffic flow to a detour
2. **MISSING MBNCA “BRANDO” with 1 passenger**
 - a. Coast Guard Romblon directed all other nearby detachments and advised all ships/ watercrafts and local populace transiting in the area to be on the look-out and provide assistance if missing motorbanca is sighted
 - b. Coast Guard Southern Tagalog had been notified and alerted for possible SAR Operations
3. **STO. NIÑO DETOUR BRIDGE**
 - a. New detour was made to accommodate traffic flow
 - b. DILG MLGOO activated the Disaster monitoring system
 - c. PNP continuously monitoring the affected area
4. **DROWNING INCIDENT IN BUSUANGA, PALAWAN**
 - a. **Busuanga DRRMO established an Operations Center in Sitio Kiwit, Barangay Sagrada, Busuanga, Palawan**
 - b. **Rescue Operations by joint PNP, PCG and Barangay officials was conducted**
 - c. **Debriefing and financial support was given to the bereaved family**

C. Region V

1. Three (3) MISSING FISHERMEN

- a. Local WASAR alerted and will commence SAR Operations when weather improves
- b. Coordinated with OCD VIII on the reported sightings of the fishermen in Borongan Province, Eastern Samar
- c. Coordinated and monitored with PCG District Bohol and PRO5 re Local SAR Operations for the five missing fishermen
- d. Coordinated with NAVFORSOL and TOG5 for availability of appropriate aircraft for SAR in Catanduanes as requested by PDRRMC Catanduanes

2. MISSING VESSEL (FB CRISMAR) with 32 passengers

- a. PDRRMC Catanduanes informed all coastal Barangays to be on the look-out and alert for possible sightings of the missing vessel and provide assistance
- b. PCG and PNP rescue teams deployed for search and rescue operations
- c. SAR team organized by the barangay officials from Viga and Gigmoto rescued the fishermen

3. Two (2) MISSING FISHERMEN

- a. PDRRMC Camarines Sur coordinated with MDRRMC Lagonoy, PNP and PCG for SAR Operation
