### OVERVIEW

- At 10:00 AM today, the Shallow Low Pressure Area (SLPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 100 KM South of Mindanao (5.0°N, 124.0°E)
- This weather system will bring mostly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered to widespread rainshowers and thunderstorms over Mindanao particularly over Southern Mindanao and Zamboanga Provinces
- Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.
