### **OVERVIEW**

- The effects of southwest monsoon has subsided but is still expected to bring scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms in Northern Luzon and western section of Central Luzon.
- Meanwhile, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 670 km East Southeast of Hinatuan City, Surigao Del Sur (7.2°N, 132.0°E).
