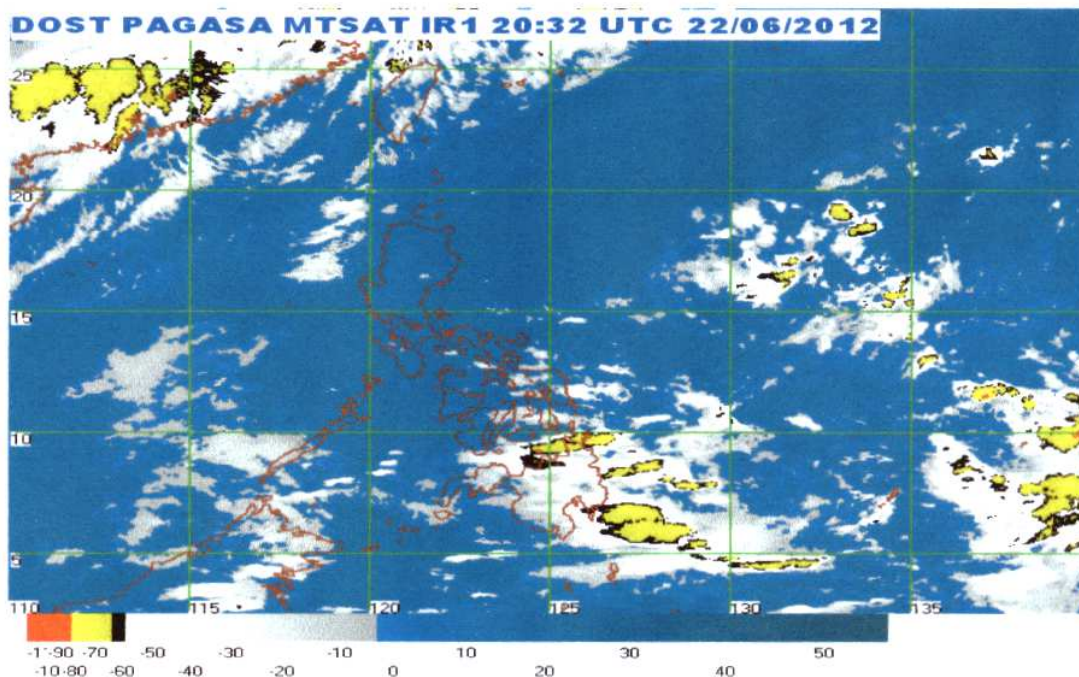

I. PRESENT WEATHER SITUATION

As of today, There is no tropical cyclone existing within the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR)



Synopsis: At 2 AM today, a Shallow Low Pressure Area (SLPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 180 KM East of Mindanao (8.0°N, 128°0 E).

Forecast: Mindanao will have mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms. The rest of the country will be partly cloudy to cloudy with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms.

Moderate to strong winds blowing from the Southwest to south will prevail over Luzon and its coastal waters will be moderate to rough. Elsewhere, winds will be light to moderate coming from the southwest to west with slight to moderate seas.
