#### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

 From the period of 01 January 2012 to 12 July 2012, 181 dengue cases were noted in the province of Albay. Identified cases were hospitalized at different government and private hospitals.

#### II. EFFECTS

- Reported cases are from Daraga amounted to 22% and 17% from Legazpi City.
- Two (2) deaths are from Camalig and Guinobatan.

- IEC dissemination and clean up drives conducted.

### RHUs/CHUs

- Conducted meetings to barangay officials on with emphasize to elimination of breeding sites of mosquitoes.
- Continuous application of larvicide and chlorination at areas identified and Olyset Mosquito Net installation on Public Elementary Schools and day care centers.
- Continuous distribution of IEC materials, leaflets and tarpaulin, on Dengue Prevention and Control Program.
