

I. PRESENT WEATHER SITUATION (as of 180500H July 2012)

As of today, there is no tropical cyclone existing within the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).



Synopsis: At 2:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) ws estimated based on satellite and surface data at 1,030kms East of Central Luzon (16.2°N, 133.0°E).

Forecast: Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao will experience mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms becoming cloudy with widespread rains over the Eastern section of Visayas and Mindanao which may trigger flashfloods and landslides. The rest of Luzon will be partly cloudy to cloudy with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms.

Light to moderate winds blowing from the Southwest to West will prevail throughout the archipelago and the coastal waters will be slight to moderate.
