1. Vehicular Accident in Romblon

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 7:45PM, 13 August 2012, an IED exploded after 10-20 seconds, after it was thrown in the main entrance of JJ Twins food center situated at the corner of Valderosa and Roxas Avenue, Isabela City, Basilan. It was hurled by unidentified suspect riding in tandem on a colored black motorcycle and fled toward the direction of Roxas Avenue, Isabela City.
- There was no casualty reported.

ACTIONS TAKEN

- Joint personnel of Isabela City Police Station, SOCO team, Basilan PPSC and Phil. Army are immediately conducting investigation.
- OCD-RC 9 Operations Center continuously monitors the situation and coordinated with the Isabela City DRRMC for any development.

2. Strong Wind in Molave, Zamboanga del Sur

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 4:00 PM, 13 August 2012, a strong wind accompanied by rains for 20 minutes occurred in Sitio Lopez, Brgy. Culo, Sitio Villasis, Brgy. Rizal and Brgy. Miligas in Municipality of Molave, Zamboanga del Sur.
- According to initial report, five (5) houses were damaged and four (4) families were affected but no casualty reported.

ACTIONS TAKEN

- Molave, MDRRMC – DANA Team is presently conducting further damage and need assessment in the area and rescue operations.
- ZAMSURECO also assisted in the rescue operations.

- OCD-RC 9 Operations Center in continuously monitoring with the situation and constant coordination with the Molave – MDRRMC.

3. Fire Incident at Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 1:08PM, 14 August, 2012, a fire incident occurred in Mohon, Tagolan, Misamis Oriental.
- The incinerated structure was a private owned wood processing plant owned by Timberwood Development Corporation.
- There was no casualty reported.
- The cause of the said incident is still under investigation.

ACTIONS TAKEN

- Jasaan, Tablon, Tagolaon and Lapsan Firetrucks responded to the scene.
