 NDRRMC Advisory on the earthquake information was disseminated to OCDRCs V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA and ARMM through facsimile, SMS and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels OCDRC VIII advised the residents in affected areas of Region 8 to evacuate immediately to higher grounds

DOST-PHIVOLCS is closely monitoring the situation and any new significant

development will be immediately relayed to all concerned.

TSUNAMI BULLETIN No. 01 11.

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL 3

A strong earthquake occurred in Guian, Eastern Samar at 8:47 PM, August 31, 2012 (Philippine Time), located at 10.83°N, 126.71° E with depth of 10 km and a preliminary magnitude of 7.7. People in threatened coastal areas are STRONGLY ADVISED TO EVACUATE IMMEDIATELY to higher grounds. Coastal areas in the following provinces are expected to be affected by high tsunami waves. Boats at sea are advised to stay in the deeper parts of the open seas until the threat has passed. If there is sufficient time, boats in harbors and enclosed bays are advised to sail to the deeper parts of the open seas until the threat has passed.

PHIVOLCS Tsunami ALERT Level is 3

Coastal areas fronting the Pacific Ocean of the following provinces should evacuate immediately:

- Northern Samar
- Eastern Samar
- Levte
- Southern Leyte
- Surigao del Norte
- Surigao del Sur
