1. FIRE INCIDENT IN PROJECT 4, QUEZON CITY

Situation Overview

- On or about 12:20 PM 29 September 2012, a fire incident broke out at no. 21 1st Avenue, Brgy. Tagumpay, Proj. 4, Quezon City involving houses of informal settlers.
- The cause of fire, number of affected population and estimated damages are yet to be determined.

Actions Taken:

- BFP-QC, QC-DPOS Rescue Team and fire brigade volunteers responded in the incident.
- OCD-NCR is monitoring the situation.

2. FIRE INCIDENT IN V. SOTTO COR. MC ARTHUR ST., BRGY. TINAGO PIER 3, CEBU CITY

Situation Overview

- On or about 6:30 PM, 28 September 2012, a fire incident occurred involving a government building in V. Sotto, corner Mc. Arthur St., Brgy. Tinago Pier 3, Cebu City.
- The incident involved one (1) 2-storey office/business building that was totally damaged occupied by 5th Engineering District Office and COA-Resident Auditor.
- Alarm level reached Task Force "Alpha" and was declared fire out at 1:10 AM.
- Total damages amounted to ₱ 1,200,000.00.
- No other casualties reported other than SFO1 Daniel Relatado who sustained lacerations at the right forearm

Actions Taken:

 Responding agencies were BFP Cebu City, Mandaue City, Lapu-Lapu City, Talisay City, PRC Cebu Chapter, Filipino-Chinese Fire Volunteers and Emergency Response Unit Foundation.
