### **1. ARMED CONFLICT INCIDENT IN MAKILALA, NORTH COTABATO**

#### **Situation Overview**

- On or about 5:45 PM 26 September 2012, an armed conflict occurred between the AFP troops and unidentified armed groups while the former which was assigned at the area was conducting reconnaissance at the boundary of Barangay Luayon, Makilala, North Cotabato.
- The encounter lasted for about five (5) minutes which resulted to the injury of Pfc Aspacio from Philippine Army. The unidentified armed group immediately withdraws at the southwest portion of the said barangay.

#### **Actions Taken**

- MDRRMC Makilala conducted assessment in the area and continuously monitors BDRRMCs for any untoward incident.
- OCD XII coordinated with the MDRRMC with regard to the peace situation of the area.

### **2. DROWNING INCIDENT IN BRGY. TABUC, SUBA, LAPAZ, ILOILO CITY**

#### **Situation Overview**

- On or about 10:00 AM 22 September 2012, two (2) minors identified as Janey Salvador, 5 years old, and Princess Castor, 4 years old, fell on the dike while they were picking up snails along the area/vicinity of the said dike. Search, rescue, and retrieval operations on that same day were conducted but to no avail.
- The following day, at around 8:45 AM 23 September 2012, the body of Janie Salvador was recovered 400 meters away from the shoreline of Sitio Singcalang, Brgy. Balcon, Melliza, Jordan, Guimaras whereas the body of Princess Castor was recovered on or about 5:30 AM 27 September 2012 along the vicinity waters of Brgy. San Isidro, Lapaz, Iloilo City.

#### **Actions Taken**

- BDRRMC members of Brgy. Tabuc Suba, Lapaz, PCG, Mountain Tigers, Iloilo City Emergency Rescue (ICER) and the 601st Philippine Coast Guard Auxiliary (PCGA) Squadron conducted search, rescue and retrieval operations for the victims.



### 3. INITIAL REPORT RE VEHICULAR ACCIDENT AT SITIO BINALOY, BRGY. BUENAVISTA, ZAMBOANGA CITY

#### Situation Overview

- On or about 6:40 AM 27 September 2012, a vehicular accident occurred at Sitio Binaloy, Barangay Buenavista, Zamboanga City. The accident involved a Cargo truck with license plate KVS-361 driven by Ernie Tamparong Y Nuneza, 44 years old and married, from Iligan City and a Mitsubishi L300 Van with license plate KDW-706 driven by Edwin Sierra. Investigation disclosed that the said Cargo Truck was enroute from Iligan City to Zamboanga City while the L300 van was travelling from Zamboanga City to Bukidnon when the accident happened.
- The accident resulted one (1) dead and nine (9) injured passenger which were brought to Cristino Paragas Memorial Hospital and later transferred to Ciudad Medical Hospital and Zamboanga City Medical Center (ZCMC) for further medical treatment.

#### Actions Taken

### 4. INITIAL REPORT RE FIRE INCIDENT IN CALOOCAN CITY

#### Situation Overview

- On or about 8:09 PM 27 September 2012, a fire incident which involved an Industrial Compound (Adobe Bricks Warehouse) occurred in 8th St., 8th avenue Grace Park, Caloocan City. The cause of the incident is still under investigation and its effect is yet to be determined.

#### Actions Taken

- Responding agencies were Caloocan Fire District and Fire Volunteers. Initial report was given by BFP-NCR.
  - OCD-NCR is closely monitoring the situation and coordinated with BFP-Caloocan but no information was given yet.
