# 1. Initial Report on Drowning Incident in Boracay Island, Aklan

#### Situation Overview

 On or about 8:43 AM 03 October 2012, a drowning incident occurred at La Carmela Hotel, Boracay Island, Malay, Aklan. Two (2) died while with three (3) were injured. The victims were on their educational tour when the incident happened.

## 2. Initial Report on Capsized M/Bnca in Boracay Island, Aklan

#### Situation Overview

- On or about 1:40 PM 03 October 2012, a M/Bca "Kevin 2" that was used for island hopping with thirty (30) Taiwanese Nationals onboard capsized near Crocodile Island and Tambisaan Beach, Boracay Island.
- The three (3) dead bodies of Taiwanese National were brought to Caticlan Baptist Hospital and the remaining twenty-seven (27) passengers were all rescued.

## 3. Progress Report on Explosion Incident

Situation Overview

- On or about 7:40 PM, 01 October 2012, an explosion occurred along the road of Purok 5, Brgy. Pupuyon, Tulunan, Cotabato Province.
- No casualties and damage to properties were reported regarding the incident.

#### **Actions Taken:**

- Elements of Tulunan MPS led by PSInsp Ronnie B Cordero isolated the area of explosion and immediately informed CPPO EOD Team. The investigation confirmed that the explosive used was a hand-grenade as the investigators recovered a safety lever/pin at the blast site.
- OCDRC XII coordinated with responding agencies for information and is continuously monitoring the situation.

# 4. Initial Report on Dengue Cases in Makilala, North Cotabato

# **Situation Overview**

- From the period of 06 September 2012 to 02 October 2012, <u>12 dengue cases</u> were reported in Makilala, North Cotabato.
- The deceased Anthony Rey Escalma Capuyan, 4 years old was first admitted to Makilala Medical Specialist on 22 September 2012. Then, he was transferred to San Pedro Hospital Davao city on 27 September 2012 where he succumbed to his illness on 30 September 2012.
