1. INITIAL REPORT RE FIRE INCIDENT IN CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY

Situation Overview

- On or about 4:09 AM 06 October 2012, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 34, Zone 2, Cagayan de Oro City damaging twenty-four (24) residential houses and affecting twenty-four (24) families composed of roughly 200 individuals. The victims are currently residing at the Brgy. 40 covered court.
- It was declared fire-out at around 5:10 AM of the same day and suspected that the fire originated at the residence of Mr. Mamerto Camingao. The cause of fire is still under investigation.
- No casualties reported. Estimated cost of damages around P350,000.00.

Actions Taken:

- **CDRRMC Cagayan de Oro** provided relief assistance to victims.
- **COFD Fire Truck and Nazareth Fire Truck** responded to the incident.

2. INITIAL REPORT RE ARMED CONFLICT IN MAITUM, SARANGANI PROVINCE

- On or about 6:30 AM 06 October 2012, forty (40) families composed of 127 individuals from Sitio Napilay, Brgy. Tulukas, Maitum, Sarangani Province were evacuated to Tulukas Proper due to the armed conflict between the twelve (12) members of Brgy. Defense Force and more or less thirty (30) heavily armed men led by certain Datu Engig at Sitio Kadapukan.
- One (1) member of Brgy Defense Force named Molok T. Lunggoyen suffered wounds due to the conflict.

Actions Taken:

- **MDRRMC Maitum** immediately brought the wounded victim to Diagan Cooperative Hospital in General Santos City for immediate medical attention and deployed a team to assist the evacuees.
- **Joint elements of PNP and AFP** were immediately deployed to control the situation.
