1. VEHICULAR ACCIDENT AT KM 4 MARCOS HIGHWAY, BAGUIO CITY

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 2:00 PM, 11 October 2012, a vehicular accident occurred at Km 4 Marcos Highway, Baguio City involving an Amianan Bus Line with plate number AYK 317 driven by Joselito Zuniega, carrying 19 passengers
- Injured victims are as follows:

ACTIONS TAKEN

- Victims receive medical attention at Baguio General Hospital & Medical Center
- Baguio City - DRRMC DOC, Police Station 10, Baguio - Benguet Public Information & Civic Action Group, Baguio City Emergency & Medical Services, Baguio City Fire Station, and Civilian Volunteers** responded in the incident
- DOH - CAR is validating the names of the victims
- OCD - CAR assisted in coordination work and monitoring of the incident

2. FLASHFLOOD INCIDENT IN LOBO, BATANGAS

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 6:30 PM, 10 October 2012, a flashflood incident occurred in Brgy. Nagtaluntong, Lobo, Batangas

- According to the investigation, an owner type jeepney carrying six (6) passengers was crossing a river along Barangay Nagtaluntong, Lobo, Batangas when a strong current swept the vehicle
- One of the passengers was rescued, three were recovered dead and two are still missing
- As of reporting time, SAR operation is currently ongoing for the missing victims

Actions Taken:

- **OCD IV-A** coordinated with the **MDRRMC Lobo, Batangas, 202nd IB** and **PCG-STL** for information of the abovementioned incident
- **AFP (SOLCOM), 202nd IB, PNP-LOBE** and **PCG-Southern Tagalog** sent rescue team to assist the local rescuers in the area
- **MDRRMC Lobo thru MSWDO** is facilitating assistance to the bereaved families of the victims

3. BOMB EXPLOSION AT CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 1:50 AM, 11 October 2012, a grenade explosion occurred in the vicinity of Maxandria Hotel, JR Borja St., Cagayan de Oro City. There were four (4) reported casualties in the incident
- Based on the initial investigation conducted by PNP, the explosion was caused by an Improvised Explosive Device (IED)
- Casualties are as follows:

ACTIONS TAKEN

- **PNP Cagayan de Oro City** is currently conducting an investigation regarding the incident and have already established the identity of the perpetrators
- **SOCO Team - Crime Lab 10** and **EOD Team - COCPO** responded and conducted crime scene investigation
- **PS 2 Cogon Operatives** conducted follow-up operation

4. GRENADE THROWING AT ZAMBOANGA CITY

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 5:00 PM, 10 October 2012, a grenade throwing incident took place at the intersection of Gov. Camins and Canelar Rd., Zamboanga City injuring two (2) victims

- Based on the initial investigation conducted by PNP, the explosion was from a grenade thrown by the arrested suspects identified as a certain Gary Candido, 20 years old from Brgy. Mampang and Albert Perez Anding, 22 years old from Brgy. Curuan, Zamboanga City
- The grenade hit a Nissan Navarra with plate number KFJ - 885
- Casualties are as follows:

- Follow up operations from INTEL Section, SWAT and Anti - Vice Section of PNP resulted in the arrest of nine (9) suspects identified as follows:

- Three (3) Caliber 45 Pistols, one (1) Caliber 9 MM, three (3) XRM Motorcycles, one (1) Honda Wave 100 and several ammunitions were recovered from the suspects

ACTIONS TAKEN

- PNP - Zamboanga City are currently conducting investigations regarding the situation
- OCD-RC 9 Operations Center are continuously monitoring the situation

5. IED EXPLOSION AT IMELDA, ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 7:40 PM, 10 October 2012, an explosion caused by an unidentified Improvised Explosive Device (IED) occurred at Brgy. Poblacion, Imelda, Zamboanga Sibugay injuring one (1) victim identified as a certain Raffy Bano y Barabadan, 14 y/o
- Victim sustained minor injuries and was brought to the Lancet Medical Clinic and is currently in a stable condition

ACTIONS TAKEN

- PNP - Imelda MPS conducted an investigation and determined the motive of the explosion
- OCD - RC 9 Operations Center is continuously monitoring the situation

6. IDP DUE TO MULTIPLE LANDSLIDE INCIDENTS IN MALAYBALAY, BUKIDNON

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On 28 September 2012, multiple landslide incidents occurred in South Cotabato displacing 109 families from Sitios of Bentung, Lemuti and Tokobokong al of Brgy. Lamlahak, Lake Sebu, South Cotabato
- The incident was caused by almost a week of continuous normal rains where in several ridges of the barren mountain slopes moved down in mass resulting to landslides.
- Residents evacuated into a safer place within the locality

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- OCD XII and PDRMC South Cotabato, MDRMC of Lake Sebu and BDRMC Lamlahak are currently conducting DANA

- **Local DRRMC** extended relief assistance to the affected families
- **OCD XII and PDRRMC with DENR-MGB** conducted meeting and scheduled to conduct technical assessment on 15 October, 2012

7. LANDSLIDE INCIDENT IN MALAYBALAY, BUKIDNON

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 3:30 PM, 09 October 2012, a landslide incident occurred in Purok 14 & 15, Sitio Panamakan, Brgy San Jose, Malaybalay, Bukidnon due to heavy rains affecting 79 families/364 persons
- Evacuation center was at Sitio Mabuhay Hall, Mabuhay Elementary School Brgy. San Jose Malaybalay, Bukidnon
- The incident partially damaged 4 houses with an estimated cost of damage amounting to Php 322, 500.00
- No casualties reported

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- **CDRRM Malaybalay personnel with PDRRM Bukidnon Personnel volunteers** proceeded to the area for evacuation and rescue operations
- **CDRRM Malaybalay** conducted DANA

8. FOOD POISONING INCIDENT IN MAKILALA, NORTH COTABATO

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 8:30 AM, 10 October 2012, a food poisoning incident occurred in Makilala, North Cotabato
- **Ninety four (94)** persons experienced stomach ache and vomiting after eating breakfast served in the Fun Run Program in the celebration of Makilala Foundation Anniversary. The victims were rushed to the following hospital for medical treatment:

- **OCD XII** coordinated with the MDRRMC re the abovementioned incident.
- **MDRRMC Makilala** facilitated the transportation and hospitalization of the victims.
- **MDRRMC Makilala** conducted assessment and validation of the total number of victims.
