1. PROGRESS REPORT RE MISSING FISHERMEN IN ZAMBALES

Situation Overview:

- **Nine (9)** fishermen aboard a twin engine boat "Jericho" went fishing at the area south of Scarborough Shoal and were reported missing since 30 September 2012.
- **On 10 October 2012, Coast Guard Action Center (CGAC) received information from Rolly Claro, brother in law of one of the missing fishermen Ricky Quidez, that the motorized banca "Jericho" was damaged and the fishermen were stranded in an inhabited area near the coast of Cabra Island, Occidental Mindoro.**
- **Cabra Island Coast Watch was not able to spot the motorized banca in the area.**
- **At about 6:00 AM, 11 October 2012, PCG Tilik conducted a Seaborne Patrol Operation at the area of Ambil Island and Tagbak in Lubang, Occidental Mindoro and was terminated at around 9:46 AM on the same date. The operation bore a negative result.**
- **On 11 October 2012, 2:00 PM, Mayor Nemar Yap of Botolan, Zambales requested for a Search and Rescue operation and apprised CGAC that the missing fishermen contacted their relatives and were within the Southeast of Bajo de Masinloc.**
- **To date, the fishermen are still nowhere to be found.**
- **The missing fishermen are as follows:**

Actions Taken:

- **MDRRMO Iba, Zambales** conducted Search and Rescue (SAR) operation and disseminated information re the missing fishermen along the coastal communities.
- **PNP and PCG Masinloc, Zambales** conducted survey in the area.
- **PCG Masinloc personnel** advised the Brgy. Officials and all fishery sectors of said municipalities to be on look-out for the missing fishermen and report to CG Station Subic if sighted.
- **PCG Mamburao verified the report and coordinated with the Coast Watch Station in Cabra Island.**
- **PCG dispatched a Search and Rescue (SAR) vessel from South Harbor, Manila en route to Bajo de Masinloc for the conduct of SAR operation.**

2. PROGRESS REPORT RE LANDSLIDE INCIDENT IN SAN LUIS, AGUSAN DEL SUR

Situation Overview:

- On 13 October 2012, a landslide incident occurred at the riverside of P-1 Doña Flavia, San Luis, Agusan del Sur due to heavy rains.
- **A total of fifteen (15) families / seventy six (76) persons were affected.**
- **The affected families/persons were evacuated at Brgy Doña Flavia Gym in San Luis, Agusan del Sur.**
- **Fifteen (15) houses, made of light materials, were totally damaged.**

Actions Taken:

- Affected families were temporarily sheltered at Brgy. Doña Flavia Gym.
- CARAGA DRRMC Operations Center continues to monitor the incident.
- **San Luis Emergency Response Team assisted for the rescue of the residents and facilitated their needs in the evacuation center.**
- **MDRRMC and Municipal Engineering Office conducted the damage assessment.**
- **RDRRMC-OCD is continuously monitoring the incident.**

3. FIRE INCIDENT IN DALAGUETE, CEBU

Situation Overview:

- On or about 8:00 AM, 16 October 2012, a residential house was caught on fire in Barangay Catolohan, Dalaguete, Cebu.
- The fire was declared out at about 12:30 PM on the same date.
- The cause of fire is still undetermined.
- The estimated cost of damage was approximately PhP 30,000.00.
- Two (2) persons were reported dead and one (1) person was injured.
