Situation Overview

- On or about 4:09 AM 06 October 2012, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 34, Zone 2, Cagayan de Oro City affecting twenty-four (24) families composed of 200 individuals and damaging twenty-four (24) residential houses
- No casualties reported and the estimated cost of damage amounted to P3,000,000.00 as per CSWD certification
- Fire-out was declared at around 5:10 AM of the same day and determined that the fire originated at the residence of Mr. Mamerto Camingao
- Cause of fire was an unattended kerosene lamp

Actions Taken:

- CDRRMC Cagayan de Oro provided relief assistance to victims
- COFD Fire Truck and Nazareth Fire Truck responded to the incident
