1. Situational Report No. 3 re Continuous Rains as of 270800H October 2012

- OCDRC2 reports that the region is experiencing partly cloudy skies.
- Continuous rains have rendered some roads and bridges impassable such as Tawi Overflow Bridge in Peñablanca, Cagayan, Cabagan-Sta. Maria Overflow Bridge in Cabagan, Sta. Maria, Isabela, and Brgy. Santiago - Brgy. Sto. Domingo Overflow Bridge in Quirino, Isabela. Daang Maharlika is passable to all type of vehicles.
- Lifelines are functional/operational
- Water level in Magat Dam is at 192.09 meters with 1695 cubic meter per second inflow and 210 cubic meter per second outflow. Buntun Bridge Gauging Station ib Tuguegarao City is at 6.47 meters and is below critical level as of reporting time

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- OCDRC2 OpCen continuously monitoring the regional situation.
- Alerted and Coordinated with local DRRMCs re situation in AOR and preparedness activities to be undertaken.
- Disseminated weather advisories to PCG, regional and local DRRMCs, and local media thru SMS and facsimile.
- PDRRMCs continuously monitoring situation in their AOR and disseminating weather advisories while local rescue units are on alert and standby.

2. Spot Report re Search and Rescue Operations in Masbate

- A motorized banca M/B Brian reportedly left Claveria Masbate on October 27, 2012 bound for San Pascual Pier, Masbate when it had engine trouble and went dead on water.
- On board was five (5) crews and one hundred eighteen (118) passengers composed of eighteen (18) teachers and one hundred (100) students from the delegation from

South Claveria South District to participate in the District Meet at San Pascual, Burias Island, Masbate.

- At 270130H October 2012, a Search and Rescue Operations was conducted by Philippine Navy from San Pascual Pier whereupon the stranded motorized banca was spotted at around 270230H October 2012 at the vicinity 300 yards NW of Cueva Point, Burias Island, Masbate. At 0430H same day, the banca was safely towed to San Pascual Pier.
- All crew and passengers are safe and no other untoward incidents was reported thereafter.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

 OCDRC5 OpCen has coordinated with LGU of San Pascual, Masbate and PCG District Bicol for the proper disposition of the passengers and crew and for any assistance required.

3. Vehicular Accident at Pingao, Cagaluan, Pasil, Kalinga

- Belated report dated October 27, 2012 11:00 AM from OIC, CARDRRMC, re vehicular accident involving a dump truck on its way to Tabuk City when it collided with a TMX motorcycle proceeding toward Libuagan, Kalinga because both vehicle took the center lane on a sharp curve. Incident happened on October 22, 2012 at 2:00PM at Pingao, Cagalian, Pasil, Kalinga.
- Riders of the motorcycle are 17 year-old Allan Licaycay Planya who suffered head injuries while Jay-Ar Salbang Cosay suffered fracture at left leg.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

 - Civilian Volunteers and Libuagan Police responded to the scene. Injured persons are being treated at the Tabuk Provincial Hospital and also referred to St. Paul Medical Center, Tuguegarao for CT-Scan
