1. BELATED REPORT OF DROWNING INCIDENT IN TANUDAN, KALINGA

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- On or about 1:00 PM, 27 October 2012, while three (3) family members were crossing Tanudan River (connected to Chico River), a strong current swept them away. Tanudan is a remote municipality of Kalinga Province.
- As of 10:00AM today, the body of Mr. Alejandro Tabbang Sr. and Alejandro Tabbang Jr. were retrieved along the river at Sitio Tomiangan, Brgy. Dupag, Tabuk City, Kalinga.
- The retrieved bodies now lie in state at Tampco Funeraria, Brgy. Bulanao, Tabuk City.

- Tabuk SAR team is still looking for Mrs. Evageline Tabbang(still missing).
- Kalinga PDRRMC provided food assistance to the deployed SAR teams.

2. VEHICULAR ACCIDENT IN CATTUBO, ATOK, BENGUET

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- On or about 8:45 AM 28 October 2012, a vehicular accident was monitored at km 57 Halsema Highway, Cattubo, Atok, Benguet.
- A Toyota HIACE Van with plate number TQA-117, while traversing the highway accidentally fell down a 25meter-deep ravine.
- Mr. Anthony Bonguilis, 25 yrs old, the driver of the said vehicle, incurred injuries and was immediately rushed to Atok Municipal Hospital for medical treatment. He was the only person on board the vehicle.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

Atok Municipal Police Station and Civilian volunteers responded to the incident.
