1. MAJOR LANDSLIDES IN PAGUDPUD, ILOCOS NORTE

I. Situation Overview

- A landslide incident occurred along Manila North Railways, km 579.100, at Brgy. Pancian, Pagudpud, Ilocos Norte approximately 200 meters after Paraiso ni Anton at around 2:00 AM

II. Actions Taken

- At around 4:30 AM, one (1) backhoe of DPWH and two (2) payloaders from LGU-Pagudpud and private contractor were deployed to clear the area
- DPWH Maintenance crew and some private equipment went to the site to assist and expedite the clearing activities. Road signages were installed to inform the motorists
- DPWH coordinated with the PNP and LGU for traffic management in the area
- The road section is expected to open one lane to traffic by 12NN today
- OCDRC1 continues to monitor the situation

2. FINAL REPORT RE FIRE INCIDENT IN SAN JUAN

I. Situation Overview

- On or about 4:56PM 22 November 2012, a fire incident involving a 2-storey residential house was reported at #604 Paraiso St. cor. Pinaglabanan Brgy. Corazon de Jesus, San Juan
- One casualty was reported dead due to suffocation and identified as Mr. Emerald Baccay (16 years old)
- There were eight (8) more or less families that are affected and an estimated damage of PhP 400,000.00
- The fire was declared out at 1752H

II. Actions Taken

- Responding agencies were BFP San Juan and other five volunteers
- OCD-NCR coordinated with Fire District 4 and requested for spot report on the incident, and prepared final report and submitted the same to OpCen for information

3. FIRE INCIDENT REPORT IN MANDAUE CITY, CEBU

I. Situation Overview

- On or about 12:05 AM, 22 November 2012, Mandaue City Fire Marshal Ronaldo Orbeta reported that the fire razed 12 residential houses at Sitio Centro, Barangay Looc, Mandaue City which are mostly made of light materials. An unattended candle was said to be the cause of the fire
- There are no casualties reported
- There are 23 affected families and an estimated damage of PhP 120,000

II. Actions Taken

- Fire trucks from Mandaue City fire station responded to the fire scene
 - All 23 homeless households were temporarily sheltered at the Barangay Looc gymnasium
 - CSWDO distributed basic relief goods
 - The 13 affected house owners will be given cash assistance P10T and P5T for the 7 renters, while 3 affected families who share the same house will receive in-kind from CDRRMC
