#### **1. OCDRC XI (DAVAO REGION)**

##### **I. Situation Overview**

- Due to the Intertropical Convergence Zone, Davao Region is experiencing intermittent rains for the past few days which resulted to flooding in some municipalities of the provinces of Compostela Valley, Davao del Norte and Davao Oriental

## Actions Taken

- Hon. Governor Arturo Uy, PDRPMC Chairman of Compostela Valley Province issued Memorandum re: Suspension of Classes to all levels and stoppage of mining activities of the whole Province.
- PDRPMC ComVal provided three (3) dump trucks, three (3) rubber boats and one (1) ambulance to Municipality of Compostela.
- Hon. Jessie S. Bolo thru MDRPMC Compostela issued Executive Order re: Suspension of Classes to all levels and mining activities to the whole municipality.
- MDRPMCs Compostela and Montevista together with PDRPMC ComVal activated Incident Command System of their respective areas.
- MDRPMC Compostela conducted evacuation of the affected families.
- MDRPMCs Compostela and Montevista together with the PDRPMC ComVal are on close monitoring of AOR.
- MDRPMC Compostela together with PDRPMC ComVal MSWDO Compostela provided assorted food relief assistance to the evacuees.
- MDRPMC Nabunturan thru MERT Response Team conducted pre-emptive evacuation of families likely to be affected.
- MDRPMC Montevista together with PDRPMC ComVal thru MSWDO Montevista provided assorted food relief assistance to affected families.
- MDRPMC Asuncion together with PDRPMC Davao Del Norte conducted pre-emptive evacuation and on close monitoring of the affected areas.
- MDRPMC Asuncion together with PDRPMC Davao del Norte distributed relief goods to affected families particularly the evacuated families.
- MDRPMC conducted search and rescue operation at Barangays Sagayen and Canatan
- The MDRPMC Council convened and passed a resolution for the declaration of State of calamity in the Municipality of Asuncion. The Sagguniang approved the resolution declaring state of calamity on November 21, 2012.
- The Municipal Health Office of Asuncion, Davao del Norte conducted consultation and medical treatment in evacuation centers and barangays affected.
- MDRPMC Kapalong together with PDRPMC Davao del Norte thru RDR Rescue Team conducted evacuation of the affected families.
- RDR Rescue Team of Davao del Norte responded to the areas affected in the province
- PDRPMC Davao del Norte augmented the affected Municipalities in terms of rescue operations
- PDRPMC Davao del Norte consolidated incident data from flooded Municipalities.
- PDRPMC Davao del Norte is on constant weather monitoring per LGU.
- PDRPMC Davao del Norte conducted ocular inspection to the affected areas.
- PDRPMC Davao del Norte conducted initial DANA.
- CDRPMC of Tagum City conducted search and rescue at barangay Canocoton.



- Responders from DOSMART-GOV.GEN., PDRRMC Davao Oriental, PNP,BFP, RECON and MDRRMC Gov. Generoso responded to the affected barangays.
- MDRRMC San Isidro together with the PDRRMC Davao Oriental conducted evacuation of the affected families.
- MDRRMC San Isidro together with the PDRRMC Davao Oriental conducted Search and Rescue Operations of the victims.
- RDRRMC XI/OCD is now on red alert status
- RDRRMC-Member agencies were alerted for possible support

## **2. OCDRC CARAGA**

### **I. Situation Overview**

- CARAGA Region continuous to experience partly cloudy skies.
- RDRRMC Operation Center disseminated 24-Hr Public Weather Forecast, General Flood Advisory No. 1 and Weather Advisory No. 1 to all RDRRMC member-agencies, Local DRRMCs and Local Radio/TV Stations in the region.
- Local DRRMCs of Butuan, Tandag, Tago and Lianga lifted the suspension of classes in all levels
- Cebu Pacific and Air Philippines flights have already resumed.
- MDRRMC San Francisco reported swelling of creeks and drainage canals and other waterways in the Poblacion area of the municipality and continuously monitors flood prone areas within AOR.
- MDRRMC Prosperidad reported flooded roads along some barangays but still passable to all kinds of vehicles.
- MDRRMC Lanuza reported a landslide incident along national highway in Brgy. Nurcia although the road is still passable.
- MDRRMC Hinatuan power interruption was restored since 20 November 2012.

### **Actions Taken**

- RDRRMC Operations Center continues to maintain 24/7 monitoring and undertakes coordination with the local DRRMCs for situational update.
  - PDRRMCs continue to monitor water level in their respective AORs.
  - The MDRRM Office facilitated clearing operation on uprooted mango tree along Bitoon-Dugmanon junction.
  - PRO 13 has activated Regional Disaster Operations Center effective 2:30 PM November 2012 under Regional PCR Division, and Regional Tactical Operations Center to monitor the ITCZ and situation within the area of responsibility.
