I. Situation Overview

- Due to the Intertropical Convergence Zone, Davao Region is experiencing intermittent rains for the past few days which resulted to flooding in some municipalities of the provinces of Compostela Valley, Davao del Norte and Davao Oriental

Actions Taken

- Hon. Gov. Arturo Uy, PDRRC Chairman of Compostela Valley Province issued Memorandum on the Suspension of Classes to all levels and stoppage of mining activities of the whole province on November 20, 2012.
- Hon. Jessie S. Bolo, thru MDRRC Compostela, issued Executive Order re: Suspension of Classes to All Levels and mining activities of the whole municipality, yesterday, November 20, 2012.
- MDRRMCs Compostela and Montevista together with PDRRC Compostela Valley activated Incident Command System in their respective areas.
- MDRRMC Compostela conducted evacuation operations

- MDRRMCs Compostela and Montevista, together with the PDRRMC ComVal are closely monitoring respective AORs
- **PDRRMC ComVal, MDRRMC Compostela and MSWDO Compostela provided assorted food relief assistance to the evacuees.**
- **MDRRMC Nabunturan, thru MERT Response Team, conducted pre-emptive evacuation of families likely to be affected.**
- **PDRMC ComVal and MDRRMC Montevista thru MSWDO Montevista provided assorted food relief assistance to affected families.**
- MDRRMC Asuncion and PDRRMC Davao del Norte conducted pre-emptive evacuation, yesterday and and closely monitored the situation.
- RDR Rescue Team of Davao del Norte responded to the affected barangays.
- Responders from DOSMART-GOV.GEN., PDRRMC Davao Oriental, PNP, BFP, RECON and MDRRMC Gov. Generoso responded to the affected barangays.
- **PDRRMC Davao Oriental and MDRRMC San Isidro conducted evacuation of the affected families and SAR operations of the victims.**
- RDRRMC XI/OCD is now on red alert status.
- RDRRMC-Member agencies were already alerted for possible support.

E. Assesment

- Downstream municipalities of Davao del Norte Province, namely, Sto. Tomas, Braulio E. Dujali, Carmen and low lying areas of Tagum City are expected to be affected by flood if heavy rains will continue.

2. OCDRC CARAGA

Situation Overview as of November 21, 2012

- CARAGA Region continuous to experience moderate to heavy rains.
- RDRRMC Operation Center disseminated 24-Hr Public Weather Forecast, General Flood Advisory No. 1 and Weather Advisory No. 1 to all RDRRMC member-agencies, Local DRRMCs and Local Radio/TV Stations in the region.
- **Local DRRMCs of Butuan, Tandag, Tago and Lianga lifted the suspension of classes in all levels**
- **Cebu Pacific and Air Philippines flights have already resumed.**
- MDRRMC San Francisco reported swelling of creeks and drainage canals and other waterways in the Poblacion area of the municipality and continuously monitors flood prone areas within AOR.
- MDRRMC Prosperidad reported flooded roads along some barangays but still passable to all kinds of vehicles.
- MDRRMC Lanuza reported a landslide incident along national highway in Brgy. Nurcia although the road is still passable.
- **MDRRMC Hinatuan power interruption was restored since 20 November 2012.**

Actions Taken

- RDRRMC Operations Center continues to maintain 24/7 monitoring and undertakes coordination with the local DRRMCs for situational update.
 - The MDRRM Office facilitated clearing operation on uprooted mango tree along Bitoon-Dugmanon junction.
 - **PRO 13 has activated Regional Disaster Operations Center effective 2:30 PM November 2012 under Regional PCR Division, and Regional Tactical Operations Center to monitor the ITCZ and situation within the area of responsibility.**
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
